Sec. 15. "Mail" means:

- (1) first class, certified, or registered United States mail, postage prepaid; or
- (2) private carrier service, fees prepaid or billed to the sender.

**OFFICIAL COMMENTS**

Because the term "mail" is used throughout the BCL, the Commission added this definition to specify the methods that satisfy various mailing requirements. The definition authorizes use both of the United States Postal Service and of private carrier services regularly engaged in the commercial delivery service business.
